2017 EVENTS OVERVIEW

The Canadian Biogas Association will be hosting two exciting and informative annual conferences in 2017, one in Abbotsford BC on January 27th, and another in the Toronto area on March 24th.

As a national organization, the CBA will cover key topics affecting our industry across the country. There will also be an opportunity for great networking among peers and industry representatives.

Value of Biogas West, held at the Pacific Agriculture Show (January 27th 2017), will be supported by the BC Agriculture Council (www.bcac.bc.ca), working with BC farmers and ranchers to distribute relevant information to increase industry awareness.
